Ralph Emerson Jack Gulden Memorial Blood/Cancer Fund Policy

The applicant may apply once every 12 months, with a lifetime maximum of 2 times, for a Grant of \$500 to cover out of pocket expenses concerning the coverable condition. (Blood disorder treatments or cancer treatments).

Receipts must accompany Grant application.

Applicant must be a current member of the Veterans of Foreign Wars, or it's Auxiliary. The applicant that is a Post member must include their member number, and Auxiliary members must include a copy of their membership card.

The following are acceptable receipted expenses:

- Treatments such as Chemo, radiation, surgical, any other medical procedure concerning cancer treatments.
- Blood work, including transfusions, platelet infusions, transplants, and any other procedure concerning blood.
- Travel receipts will be accepted in the form of fuel receipts only.
