Although membership recruiting and retention are weighted heavily in attaining eligibility for the All-State Team of Post Commanders. The Commanders personal effort and leadership of the Post are vital elements toward his or her inclusion to the All-State team.

Up to 18 Posts (with the highest scores, based upon the point schedule) will become All State Posts and the Commander and Quartermaster will be a member of the All-State Team of Posts

All State Commanders/Quartermasters will receive

- 1. First time awardees will receive an official VFW All-State Team white cap
 - a. A diamond set lapel pin
 - b. A \$50 check
 - c. All State Jacket in lieu of white cap (Quartermaster only)
- 2. Previous awardees will receive from the State Commander in lieu of a White cap
 - a. A diamond set lapel pin
 - b. An Official All State Certificate
 - c. A \$50 check

All-State General Rules and Requirements: The following is a list of general rules and requirements that each Post must obtain credit for on or before May 17, 2019 to receive All-State Award recognition for the Membership Program Year 2018 – 2019.

Those who qualify will receive the All-State application via email May 18, 2019 or via U.S. mail (7-10 business days USPS). The application must be received at Veterans of Foreign Wars Department of Colorado HQ by May 31, 2019.

- 1. Membership must meet 100% PLUS 1 by May 17, 2019 (as verified by National)
- Post must have Elected, Appointed Officers, Chairmen, & committee for 2018-2019 (verified by Page 3 & 4 or 2018-2019 Election Report and Page 4 received at Dept. HQ by Sept. 17, 2018)
- 3. Submit at least one Voice of Democracy nomination/*Participation (verification by Dept. Chair Report)
- 4. Submit at least one Patriot Pen nomination/*Participation (verification by Dept. Chair Report)
- 5. Submit at least one Citizenship Education Teacher of the Year (any level, K-5, 6-8, 9-12) /*Participation (verification by Dept. Chair Report)
- 6. Submit at least one VFW Public Servant Awards nomination/*Participation (verification by Dept. Chair Report)
- 7. The Commander must ensure all Authorized Responsible Officer(s) are bonded in the correct monetary amount by August 31, 2018.
- 8. The Post must be inspected and pass the inspection by the end of 2018 (Note: Inspections returned to District Commanders must be completed and returned to VFW Dept. of CO HQ by December 31, 2018)
- 9. The Post Commander must attend District meetings in accordance with the National By-Laws.
- 10. Post Audit Reports must be submitted to VFW Dept. of CO HQ the last day of the month following the end of the Quarter. (Quarter ending June-due by July 31, Quarter ending September-due by October 31, Quarter Ending December-due by January-31, Quarter Ending-March due by April 30)
- 11. Purchase minimum of 5 Buddy Poppies per member by December 31, 2018 (according to the membership total as of June 30, 2018).
- 12. Post must conduct at least two (2) membership recruitment events
- 13. Post must make a minimum donation of \$25 to the VFW National Home for Children (Proof of donation must be received at VFW Dept. of CO by April 15, 2019)
- 14. Post must submit a Program report form to the VFW Dept. of CO HQ preferably monthly but at lease quarterly. The Program report is used to collect information on Post participation in Community Service, Youth Activities, Hospital, Americanism, Legislative Activities, and Veteran and Military support.
- 15. 2019-2020 Post Election Report must be submitted to National and Department HQ by May 13, 2019 Page 4 Program Director list must also be submitted to Dept. of CO HQ by May 13, 2019

*If a Post is unable to garner support for one or more of the above programs (VOD, Patriot's Pen, Teacher of the Year and Public Servant) a donation of \$50 for each program will satisfy the participation requirement.

Each Post purchase Buddy Poppy from Dept of CO HQ by April 30, 2019 Total 30 Points (min. purchase of 5 Buddy Poppy per member as of June 30, 2018 membership)

Ties will be broken by these two factors;

- 1. The date a District reaches 100% membership first
- 2. If two or more Districts reach 100% on the same day, then the highest membership percentage on that date shall determine the prevailing District and the District Commander will be named and awarded All State District Commander.

Membership Mission

To recruit, retain, and mentor a stable membership base, including all generations of veterans. To cultivate a membership that is well versed in institutional knowledge and actively involved at all levels of the organization and in the local community. To establish Posts with a strong tradition of service, leadership, and community outreach.

Introduction

For the past several years, the VFW has been relatively successful in recruiting members aged 39 and younger. The only way to make this success permanent is to retain those members, recover past members, and recruit new members. We must improve the way we communicate with our members at all levels of the organization. Does your Post, District, State or Department have a newsletter, email, or an outreach team that visits fellow members? In many cases, we have lost touch with our members. We need to know who they are and what their needs are. Let us get back to basics—our first priority is taking care of our members and the veteran community as a whole.

Membership Goals

- 1. Build a strong organization for the future.
- 2. Work together to achieve the VFW's goals. The VFW National Headquarters staff is here to assist in coordinating programs, developing new membership initiatives and building awareness among our membership and the entire veteran community.

Membership Objectives

- Recruit new and recover unpaid members
- Retain and mentor existing membership
- Develop new Posts and revitalize existing Posts
- Increase Life Membership
- Increase Legacy Life Membership

Retention Defined

Although retention is <u>not</u> a prerequisite for the All-American program, it is extremely important to understand how retention is derived and the important role retention plays in accomplishing growth. The number of paid annual members in your Post on July 1 is the ensuing year's "prior year total." One more new or reinstated member is required to make up for each prior year annual member the Post fails to retain.

Your Post retention is derived from six types of payment components based on your prior year total of annual members:

- A prior year annual member pays his or her annual membership dues.
- A prior year annual member pays the life membership installment fee.
- A prior year annual member pays for life membership dues.

- A prior year annual member transfers to another Post and pays his or her annual membership dues.
- A prior year annual member transfers to another Post and pays the life membership installment fee.
- A prior year annual member transfers to another Post and pays life membership dues.

Life Membership Amnesty

All life members who are reported deceased between July 1, 2018 and August 31, 2018, will be removed from the Post rolls and the Post's prior year membership count will be adjusted accordingly.
